In the Name of God, Amen. I Hannah

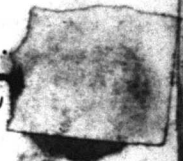
Orphan of East-hampton on Long Island in the  
but now in the Township of Newark in New Jersey.  
State of New York, being at this Time weak in Body

but of sound Mind & Memory do make & constitute this  
my last Will & Testament in manner, & form follow-  
ing. Viz I commit my Body to the Dust to be decent-  
ly interred at my Decease: And as to the Disposition of such  
worldly Estate as it hath pleased the Almighty to bestow  
upon me, I do give & dispose thereof in Manner & form  
following.

Imprimis, after all my just Debts are paid, I  
do give & bequeath unto my beloved ~~Rebecca~~ Rebecca Pierzon  
& to her Heirs, & assigns forever, all the Right, Title, & Interest  
I now have, or ever had unto thirteen Acres of woodland which ~~was~~  
belonged unto my Sister Rebecca Cook of Easthampton And al-  
-so thirteen Acres of Woodland which I now own as my  
Property in the Town of Easthampton a part of one of my  
Beds I give unto my Cousin Elisha Pierzon together with the Bed-  
-ing belonging thereunto: and all the rest of my personal Estate,  
(except forty Shillings which I give unto my Cousin Hannah  
Parsons), I give & bequeath unto my Cousin Abigail Pierzon,  
& to her Heirs, & assigns forever. Lastly I do hereby  
appoint my loving ~~Rebecca~~ <sup>Rebecca</sup> Rebecca Pierzon sole Executor  
of this my last will, & Testament. In Testimony hereof  
I have hereunto set my Hand, & Seal, this ninth Day of Janu-  
-ary, in the Year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and  
seven. 1807.
