be God for the same and considering the certainty of death and the
uncertainty of the time thereof and to the end that I may be the better
prepared to leave the world whenever it shall please God to call
me hence do therefore make and declare this to be my last will and
testament in manner following that is to say; First and princip-
ally I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God my
Creator Hoping for free pardon and remission of all my sins
and to enjoy ever lasting happiness in the heavenly Kingdom through
Jesus Christ my Saviour. my body I commit to the earth at the
discretion of my executor herein after named And I give to my
daughter Jane fifty dollars and if she dies without issue I give
the above sum of fifty dollars to the children of my son Josiah I give
to my daughter Sally fifty dollars, I give to my son Josiah five dollars
I give to my Grand daughter Elizabeth Baldwin fifty dollars, And I
give to my beloved wife the sole use of the whole of my estate which may
be left at my decease during her natural life and the residue of my estate
which may be left at the decease of my wife after paying the above mention
bequests I wish to be equally divided among the children of my son Josiah
And do hereby appoint James Vanhooken my lawful Executor who is her-
by authorized to make sale of all my estate both real and personal and
pay all my debts which may be owing at my decease out of the same
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty first day
of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
forty one
