do make and Ordain this my Last will and Testament in manner

Item I Give Devise and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife Sarah
Osburn the Plantation Inow Livo on with all the Improvements
thereon and also three of the Best Horses and likewise three of
the Best Cows and the Sheep with all the Household goods and the
Hoggs which I Give to her her heirs and assigns forever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son Isaac Osburn a Horse that
I Bought of Edward Williams

Item I Give to my Son Thomas Osburn two Steers and my Sorrel
Horse

Item I Give to my Son Joseph Osburn two Horses of one year old
each and also two Bulls of the same age

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Mearns a Horse
of two years old

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Hannah Carr
the Sum of forty Shillings to be paid out of my Personall
Estate

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Deborah Osburn
a Bay Colt
all which is above Bequeathed I Give to them their Heirs
and assigns forever

Lastly I Resemeth of my Personall Estate not already
Bequeathed I Order My Executors to pay my Just Debts
and funerall Charges with and if there be any Left Residue
paying my Debt and funerall Charges I Give and Order
the Remainder to be Equally Divided amongst my Children
above named and their assigns forever

Lastly I Nominate constitute and appoint my Beloved
Wife Sarah Gunn Executrix and my Son in Law
William Moore in Executor of my Last
will and Testament In witness whereof I have
herunto set my hand and Seal Declaring this to be
my Last will and Testament this fifth day of
July One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty nine
