In the name of God Amen I Ann Miel of Amelia County  
and parish of Rowley being sick But of sound disposing mind and  
memory do make and Ordain this my last will and testament in  
manner and form following in Impresence I give and bequeath unto  
my daughter Ann Evans Morgan one Cow and calf and my black  
Walnut Cupboard and my large Bible to her and her heirs forever. Also  
I give the horse I had of David Williams to my son in law John Morgan upon  
Condition he shall furnish my Grands son Joel Miel Osborne with a horse if he  
should live to come of the age of Twenty one Years worth ten pounds  
Also I give and bequeath my Daddles and Bridles and all my wearing  
Apparel to my daughter Ann E Morgan to her and her heirs forever;  
Also I give and bequeath to my Grands son Joel Miel Osborne my  
desk and bed and furniture and trunks one Chest. It is my will and desire  
that my son in law John Morgan keep the formentioned Articles in his possession  
until my Grands son shall arrive to the age of Twenty one years. Also  
I give and bequeath to my Grands son Joel Miel Osborne to be kept for him  
in the hands of my son in law John Morgan one Hogthead of Tobacco and  
one half Do and the sum of Twenty pounds due me from the estate of my son  
John Miel and if my Grands son Joel Miel Osborne should die before the  
Arrive to the age of Twenty one years: I give Every thing left him to my daughter  
Ann Evans Morgan Lastly all the Rest of my Estate I give and bequeath  
to my daughter Ann E Morgan to her and her heirs forever. And do appoint  
my son in law John Morgan Executor to this my last will and Testament

and acknowledged bonds with John Finney his surety in the penalty of  
900 dollars Certificate is granted him for obtaining probate in due  
form
