
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Daniel Osborn Will

In the name of the benevolent Father of us all
 I Daniel Osborn of Sullivan County in the
 state of Indiana do make and Publish this
 my last will and Testament. I first
 direct that my body be decently interred
 and that my funeral be conducted in a
 manner corresponding with my Estate and
 Situation in life and as to such Worldly
 Estate as it has pleased God to entrust me
 with. I dispose of the same in the following
 manner, To wit: First I direct that all
 my just debts be paid including my funeral
 expenses as soon after my decease as possible
 out of the first moneys that shall come into the
 hands of my Executors from any portion of my Estate
 either Real or Personal. Second I direct that my
 beloved wife, Elizabeth Osborn shall have the
 use of the lands belonging to my Estate and also
 the personal property after the payment of
 all just debts, provided she Remains my Widow
 during her natural life. Third I direct that
 my Executors shall sell at private sale without
 advertising Real Estate and Personal property
 described as follows: The north west quarter of
 the south east quarter of section twenty one in
 Township seven North of Range Eight west
 containing forty acres. And the north half of
 the east half of the south west quarter of
 section twenty one in Township seven north
 of Range Eight west supposed to contain sixty
 acres more or less. Fourth I direct that my
 beloved son Daniel Osborn shall have a
 second Rate horse. Fifth I direct that at
 the death or marriage of my beloved wife that
 my Executors shall sell all of the above
 described property both Real and Personal
 and dispose of the same as follows: Fifth
 I direct that after the payment of all my just
 debts that the Remainder shall be Equally divided
 by my Executors between the following heirs To wit: 3

 Malinda Ozborn shall have Ten dollars (\$10.) of the
 portion of money that falls to my beloved son
 M. Daniel Ozborn. I do hereby make and Ordain
 my beloved son John H. Ozborn and my esteemed friend
 James Shippman Executors of this my last will and
 Testament. In witness whereof I Daniel Ozborn
 the Testator have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
 sixteenth day of November in the year of our Lord
 Eighteen hundred and fifty six
 Daniel Ozborn *his* *mark*

 Be it known that on this 6th day of June A.D. 1857, before me the undersigned
 Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas in and for said County came personally
 George W. Pirtle one of the subscribing witnesses to the
 foregoing will, and being by me duly sworn upon his oath states that
 he saw Daniel Ozborn the Testator to the foregoing will, sign seal
 publish and declare the foregoing instrument of writing to be his
 last will & Testament that at the time of his so doing he was
 of sound mind Memory and understanding and not under
 coercion or restraint, and of full age to devise his property as
 aforesaid and that he signed his name thereto at his request
 and in the presence of the other subscribing witnesses.
